Anita,

I will call you when I get home from work tonight and try to work out an agreement on the contract. I have spoken with Bruce and have arrived at an allocation that I am comfortable with. Here is what I will advocate:

50% JLJ
35% Anita
15% Bruce

In addition, I will make a payment of \$2500 to Bruce from my royalties to account for the fact that he made it possible to get the book out by Christmas.

Please consider this carefully and agree to it if you can or offer a counter proposal. If you and Bruce and I cannot reach an agreement, what will happen next is this: AKP will send a letter drawing our attention to paragraph L of the original contract. This paragraph basically says that they can publish revised editions of the book and, if we don't help, they will employ whatever help they need and allocate payments accordingly. They will choose to allocate 25% to Bruce.
